



The common thread of Riva 1920 on the occasion of the 55th edition of the “Salone del Mobile”, is confirmed to be the great attention to research and innovation in the full respect of our corporate philosophy.

A wide space will be dedicated to the presentation of new finishes and effects, as a result of compositions and craft processes involving the use of substances as natural and organic as possible.

The new “**Vulcano**” finish, which is characterized by a black color obtained through an artisan process of carbonization which is inspired by an ancient Japanese technique, will be among the protagonists of this edition.

These techniques are the result of a thorough and careful study conducted by the Research and Development Department of Riva 1920, that more and more dedicates to the testing of new processes able to respond to market trends, while remaining true to the principles and philosophy of the company.

We will present two new finishes as concerns the oak: **ash grey pigmented and milky white pigmented**. The pigmented oil is manually applied on the oak wood, previously brushed by hand; this process helps the natural absorption of color. Once dried, we proceed to the final finishing through the use of wax.

The process of innovation and eco-sustainability, does not only involves, the external part of the furniture, but also its soul: plywood furniture assembled with **soya-based glue** formaldehyde-free and therefore very ecological (Line Zero of IBL). In this context, enters the partnership with Magister Energy Engineering – a company with innovative ideas that has chosen Riva 1920 to test its technologies in a different context, creating a synergistic combination between the Master of the wood and design, and a technology that revolutionizes habits through a unique and extremely **innovative heating system**.

The two storage units **Rialto Tower Electric** will be presented as a novelty of the Furniture Exhibition and Rialto Fly, already present in our collection, equipped with films between the iron frame and wood. This innovative technology allows to heat the environment by electricity through a radiant system.

Among the icons of Riva 1920, cannot miss the pieces of **Briccola**, poles coming from the Lagoon of Venice and the **Kauri**, millennial wood coming from New Zealand, alongside the “classic” walnut, oak and cedar wood that is reinterpreted according to new forms. For the first time, the **Totara** wood will be shown, an arboreal plant of Podocarpaceae family, endemic to New Zealand, which is characterized by a reddish/brown color and its ease in working. Some logs found on the ground of forests, have small holes and streaks caused by certain fungi that have eroded the heart of the plant.

New tables are the great protagonists of the stand Riva 1920: names such as **Michele De Lucchi** with a reduced version of the table **Pangea**, icon of Pavillion Zero in Expo 2015, **Matteo Thun & Antonio Rodriguez** with **Icon**, a table with pure lines, **Mario Bellini** with **X Table** characterized for its X-shaped base, **Alberto and Francesco Meda** with **Blend**, a mix of wood and metal, **Vegni Design** with **Oplà**, a true game of balancing, **D’Urbino and Lomazzi** with **Kikibio**, which is inspired by the art of origami; they have been able through their name to be the interpreters of the style of Riva 1920.

Among the new products for this edition you can find: **Hellen** (design by CR & S Riva 1920) chair and armchair versions, the benches **Spazzola** designed by **Fabio Lo Jacono**, **Sequoia** design by **Cengiz Civan**, **La Catena** designed by **Claudio Bellini**, the chaise longue **Dusk** designed by **Karim Rashid**, the stools: **Kono** design by **Mario Bellini**, **Vase**, **Reel**, **Molla** designed by CR & S Riva 1920, **Gumnut** designed by **David Knott** and **Ziba** designed by **Francis Kéré**.

The main event is represented by the awarding of the **3rd Design Award**, competition of ideas promoted by Riva 1920 and aimed at designers and architects, which will be held on April 15th at 5 p.m. at the Arena of the Pavillion Satellite in the presence of important personalities.


The theme of the design, bench or stool in cedar wood, has been very successful, so much that they were sent to over **1,200 projects** with a well-attended participation also by foreign designers.

They will be awarded 6 Riva 1920’s prizes by Marva Griffin, Roberto Snaidero, Giovanni Anzani, Michele De Lucchi, Gilda Bojardi and Terry Dwan and 6 special prizes (Electrolux, SCM, Tabu, IBL, Eataly, La Triennale).

Riva 1920 continues in a concrete way with its commitment towards the new generations.

Inside the stand, it will also be hosted a veritable work of art created by nature, it is **TREE LOVE**, a gorgeous pair of beech trees, whose trunks were intertwined. The dual interpretation of the message is: “Nature must be loved.” The heart is a bas-relief by Angelo Micheli and Giovanna Latis, conceived by Maurizio Riva.

A unique continent that was originally believed to include all the emerged lands. Icon of Pavilion Zero of Expo 2015 in Milan, it proposes a return to the roots and unity, without state boundaries, prejudices, differences between peoples, race and class discriminations. This table is the symbol of the union of all countries and wants to be a moment of dialogue and meeting between different cultures. A **smaller version of the original one**, it has surface of 10 square meters. The surface of the table, consisting of 19 shaped parts that intersect with each other going to compose an extra size puzzle, was subjected to a sandblasting process, capable of highlighting and enhancing the wood grain. The top, made of solid oak with glued lists and finished with natural oils, is made using vinyl-based glues, formaldehyde-free and therefore not harmful to the environment and humans; it is finished with natural oils.

The 25 legs in conical section are made of Briccola wood and are placed at the center of each piece to give greater stability to the whole structure. Top available in oak and walnut.

“Vulcano” finish for cedar

is characterized by a black colour, resulting from an artisan process of carbonization which includes the superficial area of the wood, which becomes anthracite black. Touching it, the surface is rough and milled, the finish is obtained through natural scented oils. This process is called **Shou Sugi Ban** and is inspired by ancient Japanese techniques, which use the **carbonization** of the cedar wooden structures of the house as a natural remedy against moths, mold and fires.

This armchair is made of scented cedar wood and it is carved out of a single block of wood with a 75 cm-wide diameter. It is hand-finished. Its sinuous shape, characterized by the peculiar concentric circles of the cedar trunk section, makes out of Maui a true work of art without equals. It is a furnishing element ideal for both indoor or outdoor spaces (preferably covered). It should not be exposed to direct sunlight, or contact with water and ice.
